

Motor City POCI, Chapter 91 based in Milford, Michigan, continued its consistent support of charities, particularly children's charities, on February 27. Every year, Motor City conducts fundraisers for two major such charities, one of which is the ChadTough/Defeat DIPG Foundation.

Established in 2015, ChadTough focuses on necessary research to eliminate DIPG (Diffuse intrinsic Pontine Glioma). Chad Carr, grandson of former University of Michigan head football coach Lloyd Carr, lost his battle earlier in 2015. Soon after, his parents, Tammi and Jason Carr of Saline, Michigan, established the foundation to research, arrest the development of, and eradicate DIPG. A particularly lethal form of pediatric cancer, the current survival rate is zero. After establishing the Foundation, Researchers have become confident that a cure is quite possible within twenty years, as the Foundation has garnered national attention.
